Faithfulness:

- *“Let love and faithfulness never leave my children/teens but bind these twin virtues around their necks and write them on the tablets of their hearts.”  
(Proverbs 3:3)*

Courage:

- *“May my children/teens be strong and courageous in their character and in their actions.”*

Purity:

- *“Create in them a pure heart, O God, and let that purity of heart be shown in their actions.”*
